Built into the 'Singing for the Terrified' sessions are opportunities for delegates to have small group or individual coaching to develop their own vocal skills.

All workshops will be led by highly skilled music specialists and classroom practitioners from Bolton Music Service and our partners. The sessions are suitable for all classroom teachers and practitioners, regardless of knowledge or experience.
